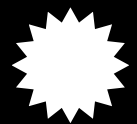

We are currently taking applications for the following courses:

- *Certificate IV in Education* (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) part time studies of 18 hours per week for adult students.
- *Diploma in Education* (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) full time studies of 25 hours per week or part time studies of 13 hours per week (over two years) for adult learners. Contributes to one year of study in Primary Education at JCU.

At Sunset we continually work hard to be the best school we can be in Mount Isa. We believe our NAPLAN improvement demonstrates we are achieving this goal. - Sunset is extremely low cost: no book list charges, no excursion charges, subsidised camps program for years 5 and 6, breakfast program every day.
- Kindy is cost free: every year we offer 30 subsidised places to Sunset families who then enrol and attend Sunset Prep the following year.
- Sunset Prep is cost free, including each child's first Sunset Uniform and hat.

We offer a calm, relaxed, hard-working atmosphere in our classrooms. We deal quickly with any behaviour issues and view any bullying (which rarely occurs) as absolutely serious: we neither expect it nor tolerate it.

In 2017 we will offer:

- Prep classes with student:adult ratio of no more than 1 to 10
- Full time teacher aide support
