<p>Hats: School bucket hat or wide brimmed hat</p>	<p>Student safety is a priority at Sunset State School.</p> <p>Sunset State School follows the SunSmart guidelines.</p>	<p>Students not wearing a SunSmart hat will miss out on play during school breaks (this includes play in the Junction Room and Library).</p> <p>Students will also miss out on participating in physical activity during Physical Education.</p>
<p>Jewellery:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Watch - Flat signet ring - Small plain sleepers or stud earrings - Medical alert bracelet or necklace 	<p>Other jewellery may be unsafe for the student or others.</p> <p>Jewellery can get caught in play equipment or cause injury when it comes into contact with other students.</p>	<p>Students will be asked to remove excess jewellery. Students can have their parents collect this jewellery from the office.</p> <p>Students will be asked to remove or tape down jewellery during sport or physical activity.</p>
<p>Helmets: Students riding bikes, skateboards or scooters to and from school are legally required to wear helmets.</p>	<p>Helmets must be securely fastened.
