## This funding will be used to

- Raise achievement standards in
  - English: students will obtain a 'C' or better for English Year 2 (75%), Year 3 (75%), Year 4 (65%) and Year 6 (75%)
  - Mathematics : Year 4 (minimum 50% of students achieving a C Standard )
  - Reading Target: by the end of 2021 90% of Prep students are reading at or above PM benchmark 8, 90% of Year 1 students are reading at or above PM benchmark 16 and 90% of Year 2 students are reading at or above PM Benchmark 20.
  - Music: employ a specialist music/instrumental teacher for extra opportunities for all children.
  - LOTE – expand LOTE program


